In Case You Missed It

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and has given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. There is a old story that is told of a famous English actor named Macready who had many flock to his performances some 200 years ago in the early 1800’s. One day a prominent preacher of the day asked him “What is the reason for the difference between you and me? You are appearing before crowd’s night after night with fiction, and the crowds follow you wherever you go. I am preaching the essential and unchangeable truth, and I am not getting any crowd at all! Macready’s answer was this “This is quite simple. I can tell you the difference between us. I present my fiction as though it were truth; you present your truth as though it were fiction.” So easy to know when something is aflame. It ignites other material. Can you imagine how quickly the truth of Jesus could spread, if we were only passionate about living it and sharing it like we believed it? Do we or is all this a fantasy? I know we don’t believe that but what we are showing and how is the question? We who know God need to be on fire, igniting the world around us not be silenced by the critics. As far as me and my household....Let’s give a little bit more truth in the life we show and who knows what others may see and catch on to. If we are living it they will for sure.
