## Scriptures Used In Todays Sermon

#### 1 Corinthians 12:4-7

- 4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- 5 And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord.
- 6 There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all *persons*.
- But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

#### 1 Corinthians 12:12-13

- 12 For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ
- 13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

#### 1 Corinthians 12:14-26

- 14 For the body is not one member, but many.
- 15 If the foot says, "Because I am not a hand, I am not a *part* of the body," it is not for this reason any the less a *part* of the body.
- 16 And if the ear says, "Because I am not an eye, I am not a *part* of the body," it is not for this reason any the less a *part* of the body.
- 17 If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole were hearing, where would the sense of smell be?
- 18 But now God has placed the members, each one of them, in the body, just as He desired.
- 19 If they were all one member, where would the body be?
- 20 But now there are many members, but one body.
- 21 And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; or again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you."
- 22 On the contrary, it is much truer that the members of the body which seem to be weaker are necessary;
- and those *members* of the body which we deem less honorable, on these we bestow more abundant honor, and our less presentable members become much more presentable,
- 24 whereas our more presentable members have no need *of it*. But God has so composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that *member* which lacked,
- 25 so that there may be no division in the body, but *that* the members may have the same care for one another.
- 26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if *one* member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

In Case You Missed It

Psalm 127:1 Except the LORD build the house they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.

In December 1903, after many attempts, the Wright brothers were successful in getting their "flying machine" as they called it off the ground. Thrilled, they telegraphed this message to their sister Katherine: "We have actually flown 120 feet. Will be home for Christmas." Katherine hurried to the editor of the local newspaper and showed him the message. He glanced at it and said, "How nice. The boys will be home for Christmas." He totally missed the BIG news — this was the first any human had flown!! So the question may be for us, how often do we miss the big picture of what God is doing in our lives right now and around us? We're so busy running around with the daily grind, sometimes even within our own lives, that we forget the amazing plan that we're a part of! There is so much work to be done and we are a part of it. We must make sure that we are daily getting focused on what God would have us do! Otherwise we labor in vain! Let's take a break for a moment, rejoice in the fact that God has an awesome plan in which He has called us to participate, and ask Him for wisdom concerning what He would have us do today.
