In Case You Missed It

Acts 16:26-30 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed. And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had fled. But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here. Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, and brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved?

At first glance, it would seem that God allowed this earthquake to take place in order that Paul and Silas would be set free. The earthquake came and their bands were loosed. There was nothing holding them back. They could have fled immediately - - wouldn't have you? The more I thought of this I would say yes. I am in prison unjustly this is my get out of jail miracle from God. Unless he told me otherwise what else would I conclude but here they don't - - Paul and Silas waited...and as a result the jailer and his entire family were saved! Many times we assume God's reasoning for doing the things He does. The Lord may have released us to walk through a door that He has clearly opened - - but He may also have other purposes in mind. Let's not be so quick to assume. There's no hurry. God won't shut a door if it is His divine will for it to be open!! Let's be patient and sometimes wait on God. Its hard in a very reactive society. Even in the days we're living in. We don't want to miss out on God's perfect will for not only our lives but also His purpose if we are driven to follow Him.
