The other answer is we can take God at his word and he does mean what he says, but the real question for each and every one of us is are we listening? Let each one today examine our hearts to see if we are following God or by our own direction " the will of man" as Peter writes or by every word of God. Good news as we will see we are not alone with this as we will find out with many biblical examples man has done this from the beginning so lets be encouraged by transforming by the renewing of our minds today.
