

Luke 17:11-19

- 11 While He was on the way to Jerusalem, He was passing between Samaria and Galilee.
- 12 As He entered a village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him;
- 13 and they raised their voices saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"
- 14 When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they were going, they were cleansed.
- 15 Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan.
- 16 Then Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine — where are they?"
- 17 Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner?"
- 18 And He said to him, "Stand up and go; your faith has made you well."

Matthew 18:23-35

- 23 "For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle the accounts with his slaves.
- 24 When he had begun to settle *them*, one who owed him ten thousand talents was brought to him.
- 25 But since he did not have *the means* to repay, his lord commanded him to be sold, along with his wife and children and all that he had, and repayment to be made.
- 26 So the slave fell *to the ground* and prostrated himself before him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you everything.'
- 27 And the lord of that slave felt compassion and released him and forgave him the debt.
- 28 But that slave went out and found one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii; and he seized him and began to choke *him*, saying, 'Pay back what you owe.'
- 29 So his fellow slave fell *to the ground* and *began* to plead with him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you.'
- 30 But he was unwilling and went and threw him in prison until he should pay back what was owed.
- 31 So when his fellow slaves saw what had happened, they were deeply grieved and came and reported to their lord all that had happened.
- 32 Then summoning him, his lord "said to him, 'You wicked slave, I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me.
- 33 Should you not also have had mercy on your fellow slave, in the same way that I had mercy on you?'
- 34 And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he should repay all that was owed him.
- 35 My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart."

In Case You Missed It

Joshua 23:14 Behold, this day I am going the way of all the earth. And you know in all your hearts and in all your souls that not one thing has failed of all the good things which the LORD your God spoke concerning you. All have come to pass for you; not one word of them has failed.

When you review the incredible happening of Jericho God had a strange and unique battle plan. He told Joshua to have the armed men march around the city once each day, for six days. The priests were to carry the ark, blowing trumpets, but the soldiers were to keep silent. On the seventh day, the assembly this time marched around the walls of Jericho seven times. Joshua told them that by God's order, every living thing in the city must be destroyed, except Rahab and her family. All articles of silver, gold, bronze and iron were to go into the Lord's treasury. At Joshua's command, the men gave a great shout, and Jericho's walls fell down flat! The Israelite army rushed in and conquered the city. Only Rahab and her family were spared. As Joshua led the children of Israel into the promised land it seemed that God had given them an impossible assignment - - to conquer a foreign and hostile land with fortified cities and armies greater than their own. They had to go forth only on the basis of God's promise. They had to walk by faith and not by sight! How did Joshua lead them to walk by faith? He reminded them in this verse that God has never failed them. And he encouraged them to focus on the promises of God! We too can rely on God's faithfulness today! Are you in the midst of a crisis? Are high mountains facing you today? If so, we want to remind you of all the ways God has worked in your life in the past! Though we often forget our promises to Him, He will never forget His promises to us!
