- 13 Let us walk properly as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and sensuality, not in quarreling and jealousy.
- 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires.

- 12 waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be set on fire and dissolved, and the heavenly bodies will melt as they burn!
- 13 But according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

**IN CASE YOU MISSED IT**

For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead. (James 2:26 ESV)

“An old Scotsman operated a little row-boat for transporting passengers. One day a passenger noticed that the good old man had carved on one oar the word “Faith,” and on the other oar the word “Works.” Curiosity led him to ask the meaning of this. The old man, glad of the opportunity said, “I will show you.” So saying, he dropped one oar and plied the other called Works, and started pulling on it and they just went around in circles. Then he dropped that oar and began to ply the oar called Faith, and pulled on that one and the little boat just went around in circles again—this time the other way around, but still in a circle. After this demonstration the old man picked up Faith and Works and plying both oars together, sped swiftly over the water, explaining to his passenger, “You see, that is the way it is in the Christian life. Dead works without faith are useless, and “faith without works is dead” also, getting you nowhere. But faith and works pulling together make for safety, progress, and blessing.”
