In Case You Missed It

I want to start this out by truly thanking God...more so than I have at times through my life. I suppose as I will tell you I truly cried out yesterday...I was by myself in my car...just giving God the glory in thanks...and what a awesome feeling it was to see all this rain we were receiving. What we have been praying for this past months and even several years. Just thanking God for hearing our cry and taking care of our needs...just like we should have been trusting all along...but the water wasn't coming and the usage wasn't going to stop what would we do without water...It got everyone concerned all the way up to the city...about a month or so ago they were implementing the next stage to limiting outside water usage to 1 time a week...and I was told by a official that without sufficient rains the city would have to go to no outside water usage at all by July...it was serious enough that our city is wanting to change money usage to explore more water sources to even charging our water bills for cloud seeding in desperation for water...but I knew all along where we could get it...in due time..His time to not only show Lawton but Wichita Falls, Altus and the whole area who really was in charge...no cloud seeding necessary...as God puts it...I got this. Everyone knows how bad our drought has been these past 4 years...with hot conditions and wild-fires these past few Springs creeping up...many that even Glenn Wampler had to be called out to fight. The other day I was noticing record temperatures for Tuesday and the high was 99 degrees in 2012. Just 3 years ago it was already near 100 degrees in the first part of May...very scary. I was seeing the first big water restriction since I moved here 28 years ago. I was concerned last year and I was confident in our God providing...I had that faith...but the faith is taken similarly like God who took his people out in the desert why because without me you can't do it in a desert...I will provide food...I will provide water...both images of God in our Bible He is the bread of life...He is the living water. So then came 2 inches of rain last week and 3 and a half in our rain gauge yesterday and more to come. This should be no surprise where all of this has come from and no

I rejoice to find them there in giving their tithes in return God says test me in this when you give in Malachi 3:10. 10 Bring the whole tithes into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this,” says the Lord of hosts, “if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows. Deuteronomy 28:12....12 The Lord will open for you His good storehouse, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. A couple in Psalms....Psalms 135:5-7. 5 For I know that the Lord is great and that our Lord is above all gods. 6 Whatever the Lord pleases, He does, in heaven and in earth, in the seas and in all deeps. 7 He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; Who makes lightning for the rain, who brings forth the wind from His treasuries. Psalms 33:6-9 6 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and by the breath of His mouth all their host. 7 He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deeps in storehouses. 8 Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. 9 For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.

And Deuteronomy 32:24 says it is all laid up in store with me sealed up in my treasuries...and I am glad that our Lord has unsealed it for what we have seen...sometimes like those in the wilderness have to find more trust in our sovereign God...we take even water for granted until it gets close to drying up...how has your heart turned to God these past years...have they been in drought or overflowing and rejoicing to the God that supplies all our needs...sometimes its good to be reminded...and I got that these past weeks...I need Him...You need him...We all need him and give him praise during times like these.
