

Luke 24:16-27

- 16 But their eyes were prevented from recognizing Him.
- 17 And He said to them, "What are these words that you are exchanging with one another as you are walking?" And they stood still, looking sad.
- 18 One of *them*, named Cleopas, answered and said to Him, "Are You the only one visiting Jerusalem and unaware of the things which have happened here in these days?"
- 19 And He said to them, "What things?" And they said to Him, "The things about Jesus the Nazarene, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word in the sight of God and all the people,
- 20 and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to the sentence of death, and crucified Him.
- 21 But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, it is the third day since these things happened.
- 22 But also some women among us amazed us. When they were at the tomb early in the morning,
- 23 And did not find His body, they came, saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said that He was alive.
- 24 Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just exactly as the women also had said; but Him they did not see."
- 25 And He said to them, "O foolish men and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!
- 26 Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and to enter into His glory?"
- 27 Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets.

In Case You Missed It

Psalms 30:11-12 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; You have put off my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness, To the end that my glory may sing praise to You and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give thanks to You forever.

I want us to notice some things from this verse today for one did you see that God turns mourning into dancing! He takes away the anguish of being clothed in sadness and replaces it with gladness. Its why he also says to cast our burdens on Him because he cares for us. 1 Peter 5:7. However, lets also notice what God doesn't do — simply stop your mourning and make it disappear. What we ask for No, He transforms it...into joy! He turns your sorrow into gladness. Makes one thing another. Not take it away altogether. He takes your failure and creates success! I believe and want you to believe also that we serve an awesome and mighty God, who says, "all things work together for good to them that love Him, and to those who are the called according to His purpose." (Romans 8:28). It may take some time to dwell a little more on this passage taking our sorrows, disappointments, tragedies and failures they are all very real — but they are also "raw material" for a divine transformation that our Lord will accomplish in His time for His glory. And we WILL dance! God will do it. Our part is simply to wait...believe...and hold tight to His word and His promises. Can we start to do that today? Will You?
