Romans 12:21! Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

A story is told of Peter Miller, a preacher in Pennsylvania, during the days of the Revolutionary War. Near his church, lived a man who maligned the minister to the last degree. The man became involved in treason and was arrested and sentenced to be hanged. The preacher started out on foot and walked the entire way to Philadelphia roughly seventy miles away to plead for the man's life. Clearly, it's our ultimate enemy. Satan, who is out to slander us, to steal from us, hurt us, lie, kill and destroy us and he'll use any means possible to do it.

In the same way, we must realize who is truly our enemy and come against him the best way we can. Determine to press forward for God's Kingdom even more than before! When we strive to do the work of the Lord, we will I'm sure gain some enemies! How do we overcome this attitude? By praying more! Learning the word more! Sharing the Gospel more! Forgiving more! Becoming wiser and stronger in the Lord! Becoming more like Jesus! Press forward toward the Kingdom of God today because our great reward is coming soon!
