**IN CASE YOU MISSED IT**

Mark 10:44-45 And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. 45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Some of you may have already heard this story but I think it bares repeating to humble ourselves once again to service.....

One day, during the Revolutionary War, General George Washington stepped out of his tent. It was extremely cold, and the wind was blowing. The demands of leading an army were weighing heavy on him, so he decided to go for a walk around the camp. In his long coat, and with his collar turned up no one could recognize him as the commander of the Continental Army, Washington came across a group of soldiers under the command of a corporal who was out to show he was in charge. They were building a tall rampart of logs and the corporal kept barking orders, "Up with it! Push harder! What's your problem?" Trying with all their might to push the final log in place up top, they couldn't do it. Every time the last log would come crashing down. The corporal would shout out again, "Up with it! Push harder! What's your problem?" Once more they would heave hoe only to have the log fall again. Washington finally ran up and pushed with all of his might and finally the log fell into place. Before the soldiers could thank him, Washington said to the corporal, "Why didn't you help your men with the heavy lifting?" He said, "Don't you see? I'm a corporal!" Washington replied, "I see." He then opened up his coat and revealed his uniform, and he said, "Mr. Corporal, when you have another such job, and have not enough men, send for your Commander in Chief, and I will come and help you a second time."

We all want to be honored, respected and appreciated. So badly, sometimes, that we try to demand it. The fact is, that these things cannot be demanded or even requested.
