

Scriptures Used In Today's Sermon

Romans 1:18

18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

2 Peter 3:10-11

10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.

11 Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness,

Matthew 25:10-13

10 And while they were going away to make the purchase, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was shut.

11 Later the other virgins also came, saying, 'Lord, lord, open up for us.'

12 But he answered, 'Truly I say to you, I do not know you.'

13 Be on the alert then, for you do not know the day nor the hour.

Matthew 7:21-23

21 'Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven *will enter*.

22 Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?'

23 And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.'

2 Peter 2:4-10

4 For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment.

5 And did not spare the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven others, when He brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly;

6 and *if* He condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to destruction by reducing *them* to ashes, having made them an example to those who would live ungodly *lives* thereafter,

7 and *if* He rescued righteous Lot, oppressed by the sensual conduct of unprincipled men

8 (for by what he saw and heard *that* righteous man, while living among them, felt *his* righteous soul tormented day after day by *their* lawless deeds),

9 *then* the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,

10 and especially those who indulge the flesh in its corrupt desires and despise authority.

In Case You Missed It

Jeremiah 31:31-33 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt: which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

This Saturday marks the celebration of Pentecost which is described in Acts 2. However, the very first Shavuot as its called in Jewish customs actually took place fifty days after the Israelites crossed the Red Sea. That was about 1500 years before Acts was even written. It was on this day that the law was given on tablets of stone.

Interestingly, it was also fifty days after the resurrection of Jesus that Shavuot or Pentecost was celebrated again. But this time, the law of God was written upon men's hearts just as God promised through the prophets Ezekiel and Jeremiah.

Pentecost is both a celebration of the God's faithfulness in the early harvest and an anticipation of His Kingdom that would come. This day, a couple of thousand years ago, 3000 Jewish people came to faith with Peters message and believed in that Messiah and was added to the establishment of His church where today because of that act we wait for His second coming and prepare for that day. Either we go to Him or He will return. Are we ready? Pentecost marks the beginning of the end of the Last Days.
