I want to do something a little different for tonight's devotional which I found on social media. It takes a story of twins in a mothers womb and compares what only they know to the outside world unseen to them and see our comparisons to a heaven we wait and long for that it too remains unseen the story goes that in a mother's womb were two babies. One asked the other. "Do you believe in life after delivery?" The other replied, "Why, of course...There has to be something after delivery. Maybe we are here to prepare ourselves for what we will be later. "Nonsense" said the first. "There is no life after delivery. What kind of life would that be? "The second said, "I don't know, but there will be more light than here. Maybe we will walk with our legs and eat from our mouths. Maybe we will have other senses that we can't understand now. "The first replied, "That is absurd. Walking is impossible. And eating with out mouths? Ridiculous! The umbilical cord supplies nutrition and everything we need. But the umbilical cord is so short. Life after delivery is to be logically excluded. "The second insisted, "Well I think there is something and maybe it's different than it is here. Maybe we won't need this physical cord anymore.
