13 Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope.

Luke 16:19-31

19 "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day.  
 20 At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores  
 21 and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.  
 22 "The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried.  
 23 In Hades, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side.  
 24 So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire'  
 25 "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony.  
 26 And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been set in place, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'  
 27 "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my family,  
 28 for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'  
 29 'Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'  
 30 "No, father Abraham, 'he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'  
 31 "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.'

Luke 4:33-37

33 In the synagogue there was a man possessed by a demon, an impure spirit. He cried out at the top of his voice,  
 34 "Go away! What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!"  
 35 "Be quiet!" Jesus said sternly. "Come out of him!" Then the demon threw the man down before them all and came out without injuring him.  
 36 All the people were amazed and said to each other, "What words these are! With authority and power he gives orders to impure spirits and they come out!"  
 37 And the news about him spread throughout the surrounding area.

Matthew 8:28-34

28 Two demon-possessed men coming from the tombs met him. They were so violent that no one could pass that way.  
 29 What do you want with us. Son of God?" they shouted. "Have you come here to torture us before the appointed time?"  
 30 Now a good way off from them there was a herd of many swine feeding.  
 31 So the demons begged Him, saying, "If You cast us out, permit us to go away into the herd of swine."  
 32 And He said to them. "Go." So when they had come out, they went into the herd of swine. And suddenly the whole herd of swine ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and perished in the water.  
 33 Then those who kept *them* fled; and they went away into the city and told everything, including what *had happened* to the demon-possessed *men*.  
 34 And behold, the whole city came out to meet Jesus. And when they saw Him, they begged *Him* to depart from their region.
