**In Case You Missed It**

There was a recent story circulating the internet the past few days that I thought I would pass along to us this evening it was about a new minister and how he made his introduction to the new congregation. His name is Jeremiah Steepok who transformed himself into a homeless person and went to the 10,000 member church that he was to be introduced to that morning. He walked around the church for 30 minutes while it was filling with people for service...only 3 people out of the several thousand people said hello to him. He asked people for change to buy food...NO ONE in the church gave him change. He went into the sanctuary to sit down in the front of the church and was asked by the ushers if he would please sit in the back. He greeted people to be greeted back with stares and dirty looks, with people looking down on him As he sat in the back of the church, he listened to the church announcements. When all that was done, the elders went up and were excited to introduce him to the congregation....."We would like to introduce to you Jeremiah Steepok"....The congregation looked around with joy and anticipation....The homeless man sitting in the back stood up.....and started walking down the aisle.....the clapping stopped with ALL eyes on him...he walked up to the altar and took the microphone from the elders (who were in on this) and paused for a moment...then he recited The passage and quoted "Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.' "Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?' "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.' After he recited this, he looked towards the congregation and told them all what he had experienced that morning...many began to cry and many heads were bowed in shame....he then said....Today I see a gathering of people.....not the church of Jesus Christ. The world has enough people, but not enough disciples...when will YOU decide to become disciples? ....Being a Christian is more than something you claim. It's something you live by and share with others.
