

Scriptures Used In Today's Sermon

Luke 19:37-40

- 37 When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began joyfully to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen.
- 38 "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! "Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- 39 Some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Jesus. "Teacher, rebuke your disciples!"
- 40 "I tell you," he replied, "if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out."

John 15:18-25

- 18 "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first.
- 19 If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you.
- 20 Remember what I told you: A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also. If they obeyed my teaching, they will obey yours also.
- 21 They will treat you this way because of my name, for they do not know the one who sent me.
- 22 If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not be guilty of sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin.
- 23 Whoever hates me hates my Father as well.
- 24 If I had not done among them the works no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin. As it is they have seen and yet they have hated both me and my Father.
- 25 But this is to fulfill what is written in their Law. They hated me without reason.

Matthew 13:16-22

- 16 But blessed are your eyes because they see, and your ears because they hear.
- 17 For truly I tell you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see but did not see it, and to hear what you hear but did not hear it.
- 18 "Listen then to what the parable of the sower means,
- 19 When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path.
- 20 The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy.
- 21 But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away.
- 22 The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful.
- 23 But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

Hebrews 4:12-13

- 12 For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow, it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
- 13 Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

2 Timothy 3:10-17

- 10 You, however know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance,
- 11 persecutions, sufferings—what kinds of things that happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them.
- 12 In fact everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,
- 13 while evildoers and imposters will go from bad to worst, deceiving and being deceived.
- 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it,
- 15 And how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.
- 16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,
- 17 so that the servant, of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world - - our faith.

I remember while growing up one of the things I would watch on TV was ABC Sports. I can still remember the opening line — “The thrill of victory or the agony of defeat!” One of the greatest prophets of the Bible, Elijah experienced his share of victories - - but he also knew that sudden feeling of defeat. If you recall, Elijah was on Mount Carmel the only prophet of the Lord standing against four hundred and fifty prophets of Baal. (2 Kings 18) When it was all said and done, Elijah was absolutely victorious! But wouldn’t you know that in the next chapter we find Elijah under a juniper tree saying “Lord take my life!” (2 Kings 19:4). We’re so quick to forget the victories that the Lord has given us, aren’t we? There are countless examples of great men of God who struggled this way. If they can go from victory to defeat so easily, how much more are we susceptible to the same attacks of the enemy? We must remember that this is precisely what they are attacks of the enemy upon our lives - - attempting to draw our attention away from all that God has done. If you are finding yourself in the midst of a valley - - try focusing on the victories the Lord has already displayed in your life. And more importantly focus on the power of victory you can walk with today!
