In Case You Missed It

Luke 12:39-40 But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into. Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man comes at an hour when you think not.

A Jewish Rabbi by the name of Eliezer said, "Repent one day before your death." His students asked him, "Does one know what day they will die?" "So he said then all the more reason to repent today," he replied, "lest you die tomorrow, and now your whole life is spent in repentance. "I don't know about you but when I first became a believer, I thought by simply dealing with my outward sins I could have this Christian thing licked and I could seem more sinless. But it wasn't long before His word began revealing and dealing with my inward sins and attitudes. And the longer I walk with Him, I understand more and more the meaning of daily repentance! But how many of us really pay attention to it and especially on a daily basis do we possibly dismiss it all together. If we truly want to be free we cannot avoid this crucial requirement for freedom. Because we cannot receive His forgiveness without it, repentance must be a way of life for us AS 1 John 1:9 points out staying close to the Lord is His heart's desire for us...but one of the main conditions for it is walking in regular repentance. When we walk in humility and truthfulness about our sin - - we are walking in the light, and the blood of Jesus keeps cleansing us from sin. In that condition we are so much more able to love the Lord and those around us and with being in Him, we can help touch one life at a time. So, let's try to learn more of daily genuine repentance!
