7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man, though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.

John 15:12-13

12 "This is My commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you.

13 Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for his friends.

Matthew 18:23-35

23 "For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his slaves.

24 When he had begun to settle them, one who owed him ten thousand talents was brought to him.

25 But since he did not have the means to repay, his lord commanded him to be sold, along with his wife and children and all that he had, and repayment to be made.

26 So the slave fell to the ground and prostrated himself before him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you everything.'

27 And the lord of that slave felt compassion and released him and forgave him the debt.

28 But that slave went out and found one of his fellow slaves who owed him a hundred denarii; and he seized him and began to choke him, saying, "Pay back what you owe."

29 So his fellow slave fell to the ground and began to plead with him, saying, 'Have patience with me and I will repay you.'

30 But he was unwilling and went and threw him in prison until he could pay back what was owed.

31 So when his fellow slaves saw what had happened, they were deeply grieved and came and reported to their lord all that had happened.

32 Then summoning him, his lord said to him, 'You wicked slave, I forgave you all that debt because you pleaded with me.

33 Should you not also have had mercy on your fellow slave, in the same way that I had mercy on you?'

34 And his lord, moved with anger, handed him over to the torturers until he could repay all that was owed him.

35 My heavenly Father will also do the same to you, if each of you does not forgive his brother from your heart.

In Case You Missed It

1 Corinthians 12:12 Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ.

I'm sure many of us have read this passage and seen how each body part makes up the body and we see that no one part is more important than another. As members of the body of Christ, we can also be compared to pieces in a jigsaw puzzle. Just think most pieces are incomplete and that's why for those who put it together has to see the whole picture they see outside each piece they may even have to look at the box photo to get clues because as we know with a puzzle each piece has its strengths and weaknesses the part we recognize plays to our strengths like in the body are (gifts, talents, abilities), and the part that is unseen or not quite evident can represent our weaknesses (faults, limitations, shortcomings, undeveloped areas). The beautiful thing is that the pieces complement one another and produce a beautiful whole. Just as each piece of a puzzle is important, so each member of the body is important and can minister to the other members of the body. And just as when one piece is missing from a puzzle, it's absence is very obvious and damages the picture, so also is the whole weakened when we are absent from the body of Christ.
