**Character Test:** What will be the influence of my moral and spiritual stamina?

**Publicity Test:** Would I be willing for friends, fellow Christians, the elders and the preacher to know about it?

**Common Sense Test:** Does it agree with plain everyday, ordinary common sense?

**Fairness Test:** Is it honest, and is it practicing the golden rule?

**Problem Test:** Is it potentially harmful to me and/or others?
