

Scriptures Used in Today's Sermon

2 Peter 3:10-11

- 10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.
- 11 Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness.

2 Samuel 6:1-8

- 1 Now David again gathered all the chosen men of Israel, thirty thousand.
- 2 And David arose and went with all the people who were with him to Baale-judah, to bring up from there the ark of God which is called by the Name, the very name of the Lord of hosts who is enthroned above the cherubim.
- 3 They placed the ark of God on a new cart that they might bring it from the house of Abinadab which was on the hill, and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, were leading the new cart.
- 4 So they brought it with the ark of God from the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill; and Ahio was walking ahead of the ark.
- 5 Meanwhile, David and all the house of Israel were celebrating before the Lord with all kinds of instruments made of fir wood, and with lyres, harps, tambourines, castanets and cymbals.
- 6 But when they came to the threshing floor of Nacon, Uzzah reached out toward the ark of God and took hold of it, for the oxen nearly upset it.
- 7 And the anger of the Lord burned against Uzzah, and God struck him down there for his irreverence; and he died there by the ark of God.
- 8 David became angry because of the Lord's outburst against Uzzah, and that place is called Perez-uzzah to this day.

1 Kings 13:11-25

- 11 Now an old prophet was living in Bethel; and his sons came and told him all the deeds which the man of God had done that day in Bethel; the words which he had spoken to the king, these also they related to their father.
- 12 Their father said to them, "Which way did he go?" Now his sons had seen the way which the man of God who came from Judah had gone.
- 13 Then he said to his sons, "Saddle the donkey for me." So they saddled the donkey for him and he rode away on it.
- 14 So he went after the man of God and found him sitting under an oak; and he said to him, "Are you the man of God who came from Judah?" And he said, "I am."
- 15 Then he said to him, "Come home with me and eat bread."
- 16 He said, "I cannot return with you, nor go with you, nor will I eat bread or drink water with you in this place.
- 17 For a command came to me by the word of the Lord, "You shall eat no bread, nor drink water there; do not return by going the way which you came."
- 18 He said to him, "I also am a prophet like you, and an angel spoke to me by the word of the Lord, saying, "Bring him back with you to your house, that he may eat bread and drink water." But he lied to him.'
- 19 So he went back with him, and ate bread in his house and drank water.
- 20 Now it came about, as they were sitting down at the table, that the word of the Lord came to the prophet who had brought him back;
- 21 And he cried to the man of God who came from Judah, saying, "Thus says the Lord, 'Because you have disobeyed the command of the Lord, and have not observed the commandment which the Lord your God commanded you, But have returned and eaten bread and drunk water in the place of which He said to you, "Eat no bread and drink no water;" your body shall not come to the grave of your fathers.'
- 22 It came about after he had eaten bread and after he had drunk, that he saddled the donkey for him, for the prophet whom he brought back.
- 24 Now when he had gone, a lion met him on the way and killed him, and his body was thrown on the road, with the donkey standing beside it; the lion was also standing beside the body.
- 25 And behold, men passed by and saw the body thrown on the road, and the lion standing beside the body, so they came and told it in the city where the old prophet lived.

In Case You Missed It

Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: therefore be wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

Again nature can provide us with an illustration that closely parallels the tactics employed by our adversary who by many people standards has been watered down and minimized his ability almost rejecting Peter's words AS he says is like a roaring lion going back and forth to see who he may devour....According to scientists, Arctic polar bears feed almost entirely on seals. Sometimes to help entice their meal, they sometimes resort to a cunning bit of trickery. If the hole through which the seal gets his food is near the edge of the ice, the polar bear will take a deep breath and swim under water to its exact location. Remaining below the surface, he will then make a tiny scratching sound, imitating a fish. When the seal hears this, he dives in for a quick supper, only to find himself suddenly entrapped by this huge, hungry embrace of his predator. As this passage points out God too has sent us forth as sheep among the wolves. There are so many theories disguising themselves as Godly. We may start to hunger for it -- but we must be wise enough to make sure it's not a trap! Keep reading and studying the word of God! Pray and ask Him to reveal His truth.
