After Mt. St. Helens blew up in 1980, one church needed a great deal of cleaning up. Ash was in the parking lot and all over the inside because of open windows. A woman met the minister in the hallway on that Friday and asked "Why don't we get the High School and College kids to come in and help poor Fred clean this place up? Let's get them involved," "Great idea," he said, "Would you be willing to get some women together to cook lunch for us?" "Well actually we had plans tomorrow and I don't know when we'll be back." Sad but true we hear on occasions from the great idea people coming up and saying do you know what the Church can do. And I would say great when can we get started. At one time I was told I just come up with ideas. Well actually the ideas for all this has already been given to all of us through scripture. And I know its so much easier to volunteer someone else for a job needing done. But who will do it? Will we? It's so easy to get into the mindset that serving God is a chore, it's our job, our duty we give "valuable consideration" to our giving, as Webster describes it. The fact of the matter is that God loves a cheerful giver. He loves a volunteer. When I think of that verse, the first thing that most come up with is monetary giving, but God wants us to cheerfully volunteer every good thing He has allowed us to have — things we often take for granted — our time, our energy our abilities, our talents, our homes, our cars, our families — all that we have — all that He has cheerfully given to us!
